You must read six nights and have log signed for credit; any forgery results in a score of 0. Parents, research has shown that the best way to improve reading skills is simply to READ more! One of the goals of our language class is to ensure that students read regularly and consistently, for pleasure. The Home Reading Log is used to keep track of what, how often, and how long students read at home.

Let me explain how home reading works: students are encouraged to select material from the genre of their choice and **read at least twenty minutes a night, three times a week at home**. After each reading session, your child will fill out the *summary of reflection section*. You may have your child read silently or aloud; however, parents (or siblings) reading along with their son or daughter is even better and highly encouraged. Parents, please help monitor your child's home reading activities by *signing the log each day only after your son or daughters reads you his or her summary or reflection*. Please feel free to ask probing questions about that night's reading. You'll find a link of literature-related questions on my Walkertown website.
